The week was filled with amazing activities, including author visits, incursions and finishing the week with a Book Week Dress Up Day Parade.













For National Science Week, students participated in a variety of practical activities. The theme for this year is Innovation: Powering Future Industries.

Students completed a number of design based activities such as creating paper chains, paper planes, building cup towers and making 3D shapes out of different materials. Other science experiments helped the younger students learn about chemical reactions, such as blowing up balloons with bicarb soda and vinegar. In STEAM, we completed practical experiments related to our topic this term in physical science.

It was a perfect day for an athletics meet with the field events being up first, followed by the track events. Our students did a great job coming away with some excellent results across the field and track events. Hats

As per the school's SunSmart policy, from Monday 14th August, all staff and students are required to wear a sun hat during recess, lunchtime and outdoor sport. Any child without a hat will be limited to play in a shaded area.
