We would like to thank our parents, carers, families and all who came to see the shows. With such great attendance, the students were able to shine in front of a full house on the night.

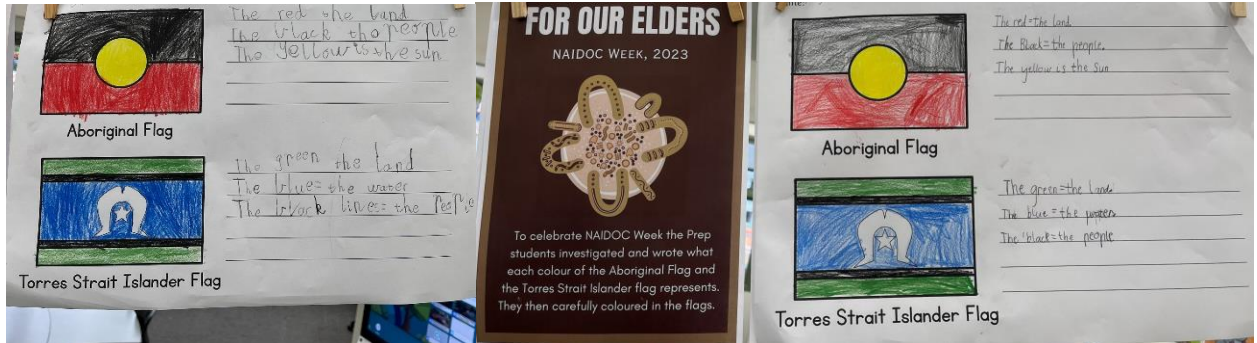

Each year across Australia, the Children's Book Council of Australia bring children and books together to celebrate Book Week. This year, Book Week will run from the 21st – 25th of August.

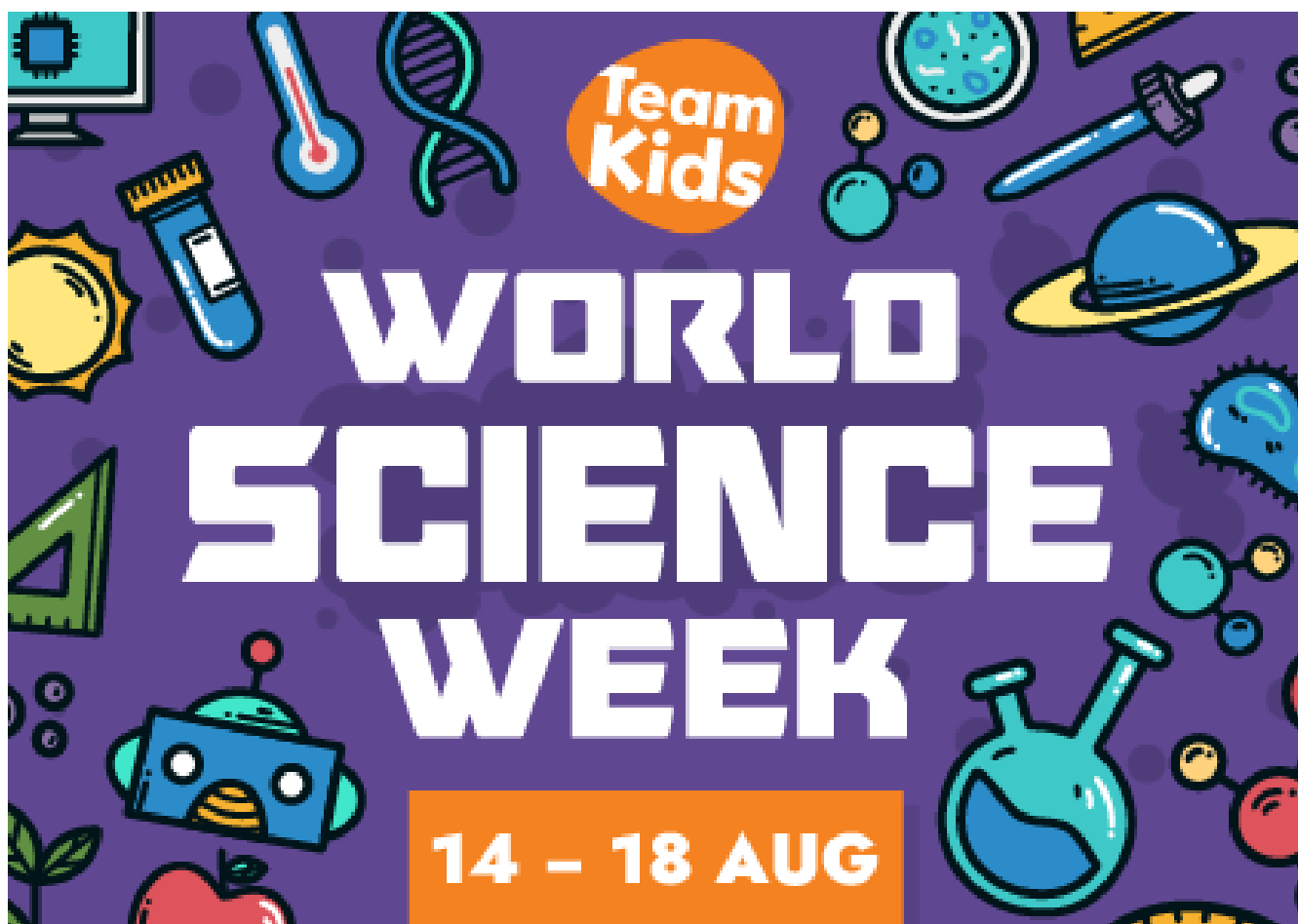

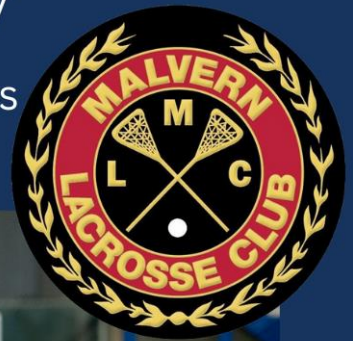
