




Congratulations Edison






Mothers Day Stall

Child Safety Training – Volunteers

Thank you to all parents who joined us online for our Child Safety Volunteers training in Term One. Our next Training session will be held online at 7:00pm on Thursday May 11^{th.} Please keep an eye on Compass for more details.

As part of our commitment to ensuring a Child Safe environment, all persons who volunteer at the school **must**:

- -Undertake Child Safety training provided by the school; and
- -Sign and agree to the School's Child Safety Code of Conduct (copies available at the school office); and
- -Provide their Working with Children (WWC) Clearance to the school for a copy to be made and kept on file.

Recent updates to the Child Safe Standards, require all future volunteers to undertake updated training after 1 July 2022 (regardless of prior training/experience). Without this training you will be unable to assist in school programs as a volunteer. A register of trained volunteers will be held at the school office with your signed Code of Conduct and your WWC Clearance.

Volunteers include parents and carers volunteering as part of school programs where students are present, including helping as part of the PFA, as parent helpers in the classroom, on excursions, school sporting events, swimming program and on camp. Please refer to the school's <u>Volunteers Policy</u> and <u>Volunteers Induction Pack</u> for further detail.


